
User Guide: Firmware Update for SMART-CAL360

Prerequisites


- Log in to your SCAL360 account
- Smart-Cal360 station is powered on and connected to the network

Part 1: Download the Latest Firmware

1. From the left sidebar, navigate to **Settings** and then select the **OTA Update** tab (See Appendix for definitions of all on-screen items).




2. Click the Check for Updates button. The system will populate table with the latest released firmware versions of all your instruments.


- 3. Once the list is populated, the Download button (cloud icon) and Change Log buttons will become active for any available updates.
- 4. Click the Download button for the Smart-Cal360 to download the latest firmware file.
- 5. Upon successful download, a confirmation message will appear, and the version number of the downloaded firmware will be displayed in the Downloaded Version column



You have now stored the new firmware in SCAL360 and are ready to apply it to your station(s)

Part 2: Update a Single SMART-CAL360 Station

- 6. Navigate to **Stations** from the left sidebar and select the **SMART-CAL360** tab. Then, select the individual station you wish to update.
- 7. Click the **Update** button. From the pop-up list, enable the **SMART-CAL360 App** option.





- 8. The new firmware file will transfer to the selected Smart-Cal360 station. Upon successful transfer, a "File Sent Successful" message will appear, and the station will automatically restart.
- After the station restarts and returns to its home screen, it will communicate with SCAL360.
 The updated firmware version will be displayed on the top-left of the application's screen, confirming a successful update.



Part 3: Update Multiple Smart-Cal360 Stations

 Navigate to Settings > OTA Update. Toggle ON the Enable SMART-CAL360 Software Update




Navigate to Stations > SMART-CAL360 tab. Click the Update button at the top-left of the screen.



8. In the pop-up list, enable **SMART-CAL360 App**. The system will now transfer the new firmware to all Smart-Cal360 stations that require an update. Stations that are already up-to-date will display: "**SMART-CAL360 station is up to date**".



- 9. For each station receiving the update, a "File Sent Successful" message will appear, and the station will automatically restart.
- 10. Once the station restarts and communicates with SCAL360, the updated firmware version will be displayed in the station card within the SCAL360 application.

Appendix

- 1. **Check for Updates**: Checks for newly released firmware for all instruments, calibration stations and applications in your ecosystem
- 2. **Allow Update Toggle**: Enables or disables the ability to transfer files from SCAL360 to instruments and stations. This **must** be toggled ON to perform firmware updates.
- 3. **Firmware Name**: The name of the instrument or application the firmware applies to
- 4. **Downloaded Version**: Shows the firmware version currently stored in your SCAL360 application
- 5. Released Version: Shows the latest firmware version released by SENSIT
- 6. **Download (cloud icon)**: The button is enabled when a newer released firmware version is available. Click it to download the latest firmware to SCAL360.
- 7. **Change log:** Enabled when a new released firmware is available. It details the improvements, fixes and changes in the new version.
